1. Since 25 May 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) has been in force.

We hereby inform you that Tamson Instruments BV processes personal data relating to your company. We process this data **exclusively** for the purpose of managing and executing the business relationship between our two companies. The data is not used for any other purposes and is not shared with third parties, except where strictly necessary for the performance of our agreement (e.g. shipping partners). We take appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your data against unauthorised access, loss, or misuse.

2. Which data do we store?

Tamson Instruments BV only stores the data necessary to conduct business with you:

- Company name
- Company address
- Company-specific identifiers (e.g. VAT/Tax number, Chamber of Commerce number)
- Phone number
- E-mail address
- Company website
- Contact person's name
- Contact person's job title / function
- Contact person's email address

3. What do we do with your data?

We use the data solely for the following purposes:

- Preparing and sending quotations
- Processing and fulfilling orders
- Shipping and logistics
- Pricing and account management on our website
- Sending newsletters and product information (**only** to registered dealers who have opted in)

4. How can you view your data?

- If you have an account on our website, you can view and manage the data you entered by logging in.
- For a complete overview of all data we hold about your company, you can submit a request by e-mail to sales@tamson.nl.

5. What rights do you have?

As a data subject you have the following rights under the GDPR:

- Right of access (view your data)
- Right to rectification (correct inaccurate data)
- Right to erasure (“right to be forgotten”)
- Right to object to processing
- Right to data portability (receive your data in a structured, commonly used format)
